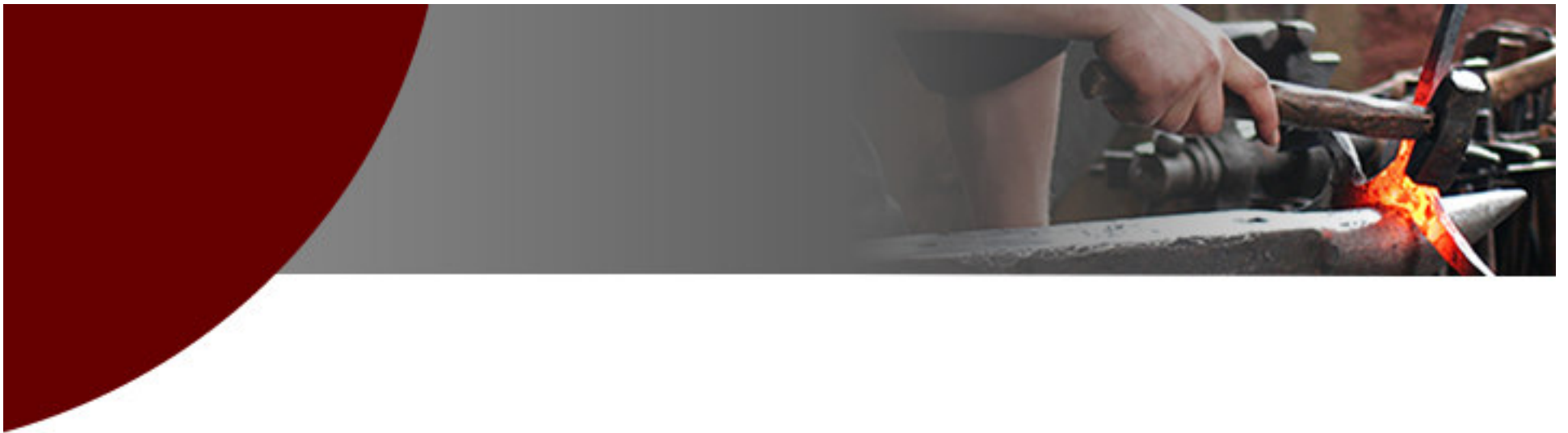






Your children like
